

Special Conditions of Hire during Covid-19

Hirers will be responsible for those attending an activity or event.

You are asked to keep contact details for 3 weeks and inform both the Village Hall and the NHS Track and Trace program if required.

You will be responsible for wiping down all the surfaces that will be used, before and after, with the disinfectant spray and paper towels provided and ensure they are disposed of in the bins.

Hand sanitiser is provided at the entrance and must be used on entry.

The Community Hall toilets are open and limited to 2 people at any one time (the Play-school toilets cannot be used). Disinfectant and towels are provided in both the female and male changing rooms which must be used as instructed (shown on posters displayed in each toilet)

The Kitchen is closed to Hirers and crockery and equipment are not to be used,

Please keep the premises well ventilated throughout your hire, as far as possible.

Tables and chairs are available on request, please make sure they are wiped down after use with the disinfectant spray provided.

Two metre distancing must be observed between people from different households. For areas where this is not possible, face masks should be worn.

Pods of two households may gather inside, up to the maximum number dependent on the event and safety arrangements being put into place by the hirer. Some events may not be considered safe by the Trustees, including activities that encourage shouting or physical activities that would increase the risk from aerosol and droplet transmission.

All classes being held at the Hall are limited to 8 in the Community Hall and 10 in the Preschool. The Preschool Hall cannot be hired during the week in term times.
